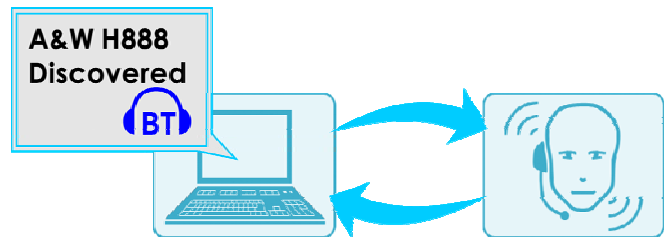

CAMagic iOdio allows you to:

- Use Bluetooth technology to pair the headset automatically
- Select a preferred audio device for the Skype® Software program
- Receive VoIP calls on the headset, even while listening to music
- Manually switch the headset mode using the convenient system tray menu
- Use the system audio device when the headset is unavailable without changing the audio settings

Easy wireless connection!

CAMagic iOdio is especially designed for Bluetooth data transfer, and has a search and pair program that automatically connects the headset device. After CAMagic iOdio locates headsets in the immediate area, simply choose one to pair with the program. You can even set the paired headset as default, which allows the program to reconnect without repeating the pairing procedure.



Independent audio for Skype® Software!

For VoIP with Skype® Software, CAMagic iOdio lets you select a preferred audio device. You can set up the program to send your Skype Software audio to your headset, so you can answer calls even while listening to music on your computer speakers. The program is intelligent enough to pause the music for an IP call, and will default to the system audio device if the headset is unavailable. You can also manually switch the headset audio mode using the convenient system tray menu.

CAMagic iOdio prevents conflict with the OS audio configuration. The CAMagic iOdio setting for preferred system audio device will reset the audio device in the Windows® control panel, and vice versa. The Skype preferred audio device applies only to audio carried over Skype, giving the VoIP application an independent setting.

CAMagic iOdio works with Bluetooth stack drivers from both Toshiba and Broadcom, and runs on Windows® 2000 and Windows XP operating systems.

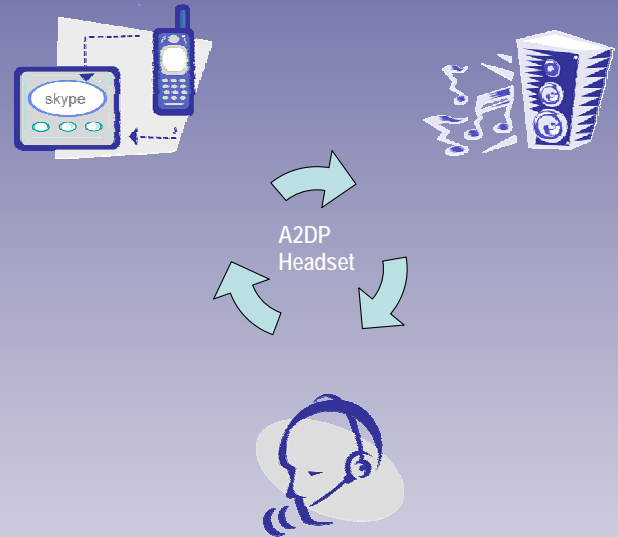

Handsfree VoIP!

Now you can take VoIP calls on your headset without changing the audio settings on your PC or laptop.



CAMagic iOdio routes incoming VoIP calls to your headset whenever it's connected. Pick up and hang up the calls by simply clicking your headset button. If you're listening to music at the same time, CAMagic iOdio will pause your media player when you answer the call, and restart it when you hang up.

You'll be notified of an incoming call with a beep on your headset, even if you're listening to music in stereo mode. If you accept the call, CAMagic iOdio will pause the music and automatically switch from using A2DP profile (stereo mode) to headset profile (mono mode) so you can have a two-way conversation over your Bluetooth headset connection. After you hang up the call, CAMagic iOdio switches back to using A2DP profile. With CAMagic iOdio, you can enjoy music and IP calls on your headset without ever adjusting the audio settings.
